The Islamic World Heritage Committee (IWHC) held its 11th meeting on 18 December 2023 at the kind invitation of H.E. Dr. Salim M. AlMalik, Director-General of the Islamic World Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (ICESCO).

The Meeting saw the participation of twelve (12) representatives from the (14) Member States, who were designated members of the Islamic World Heritage Committee during the 12th Conference of Culture Ministers in the Islamic world, held in Doha on 25-26 September 2023¹.

The Member States' representatives in the Committee took part in this meeting and addressed the following items on the agenda:

- Presentation of the draft agenda of the 11th session of the Islamic World Heritage Committee;
- Election and accreditation of the new Bureau members;
- Presentation of the activity report of the Islamic World Heritage Center;
- Presentation of the strategy program to combat trafficking in cultural heritage property;
- Presentation of the living human treasures program;
- Presentation of ICESCO guides for the protection, safeguarding and preservation of the heritage of the Islamic world;
- Presentation of the Project of "Preserving the Minarets of the Islamic World and Preparing a Nomination files for their Inscription on the Heritage List":
- Study of the cultural properties' inscription files on the tentative list;
- Study of the cultural properties and elements inscription files on the Islamic World Heritage List.

During the opening session, Dr. Mohamed Zinelabidine, Head of

Culture and Communication Sector, welcomed the Committee Members, expressed his gratitude, and wished success for the meeting of **H.E. Dr. AlMalik**, ICESCO Director-General. He then highlighted the key role of the IWHC in safeguarding the historical, civilizational and natural landmarks as well as the intangible elements of cultural heritage in the Islamic world.

In addition, he presented the achievements of the Culture and Communication Sector and ICESCO's new vision in this field, noting the dynamic and renewed nature that characterizes the cultural identity in the Islamic world, as well as the need to preserve the richness and cultural diversity of each Member State.

Thereafter, **Dr. Zinelabidine** presented the agenda of the meeting as follows:

- Presentation of the draft agenda of the 11th session of the Islamic World HeritageCommittee;
- Election and accreditation of the new Bureau members;
- Presentation of the activity report of the Islamic World Heritage Center;
- Presentation of the strategy program to combat trafficking in cultural heritage property;
- Presentation of the living human treasures program;
- Presentation of ICESCO guides for the protection, safeguarding and preservation of the heritage of the Islamic world;
- Presentation of the Project of "Preserving the Minarets of the Islamic World and Preparing a Nomination files for their Inscription on the Heritage List";
- Study of the cultural properties' inscription files on the tentative list;
- Study of the cultural properties and elements inscription files on the Islamic World Heritage List.

Having approved the Agenda and Programme of the Meeting, the Committee's members adopted its new Rules of Procedure and composed its Bureau. Given that the Islamic World Heritage Center received only one nomination from the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia for the Committee Chair position, its representative was elected by acclamation and the other two Bureau members were elected by consensus for a



period of three (3) years. Thus, the members of the new Bureau are as follows:

Chair:

Eng. Mohammad Alaidaroos, Representative of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia;

Vice-Chair:

Dr. Fadi Balaawi, Representative of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan;

Rapporteur:

Ms. Ndeye Khady Diouf, Representative of the Republic of Senegal.

After composing the new Bureau, the IWHC Chair, Eng. Mohammad Alaidaroos, new president of the Committee, thanked ICESCO for its efforts to safeguard the heritage of the Islamic World, as well as the Committee Secretariat and members for their keenness to hold this meeting, and for the quality of the documents submitted for the consideration of the Committee members during the 11th session of the Committee.

Over one full day, the Committee discussed and adopted the items on its Agenda to issue the following decisions:

Decision No. 1: Activity Report of the Center of Heritage in the Islamic World 2023:

- ICESCO's General Directorate made a presentation in this regard;
- The Committee adopted the Activity Report, taking account of the observations made by the Committee Members;
- The Committee called on the General Secretariat to disseminate the Activity Report to the Member States to highlight the role of the Center of Heritage in the Islamic World.

Decision No. 2: Presentation on the Strategy to Combat Illicit Trafficking of Cultural Heritage:

- ICESCO's General Directorate made a presentation in this regard;
- The Committee adopted the annexed document, taking into account the observations made by the Committee Members;
- The Committee called on the Member States to join the efforts of ICESCO to combat illicit trafficking of cultural property.



Decision No. 3: Presentation on the Living Human Treasures Program:

- ICESCO's General Directorate made a presentation in this regard;
- The Committee adopted the annexed document, taking into consideration the Committee Members' observations to be integrated into the final document;
- The Committee called on the Member States to promote the Organization's vision in order to highlight the contributions of certain holders of knowledge, know-how, and skills from the Islamic world;

Decision No. 4: Presentation on ICESCO's Guides for Protecting, Preserving and Promoting the Islamic World Heritage:

- ICESCO's General Directorate made a presentation in this regard;
- The Committee expressed its appreciation for the quality of the documents which cover the various international normative instruments relating to the protection, safeguarding and enhancement of cultural property and elements;
- The Committee called upon ICESCO's General Directorate to disseminate the Organization's guides to the Member States and organize training workshops on the use of these guides for the benefit of heritage specialists;
- The Committee called on the Member States to cooperate with ICESCO to integrate these guides into their relevant heritage policies.

Decision No. 5:

Presentation on the Project of Preserving the Minarets of the Islamic World and Preparing a Nomination File for their Inscription on the Heritage List:

- ICESCO's General Directorate made a presentation in this regard;
- It has been agreed to include this project in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia's Program on Hajj Routes to and from Makkah and historical mosques, explore the ways to inscribe this element on the Islamic World Heritage List and the World Heritage List.

Decision No. 6: Periodic Review of the Inscription Process on the Islamic World Heritage List and the Committee's Role in Promoting the Cultural Heritage of the Islamic World:

- 1- Recalling the need for a periodic review of the inscription process on the Islamic World Heritage List to ensure a balanced and credible list;
- 2- Taking into consideration the following procedures during the review of the inscription process:
 - Ensuring autonomy and harmony during the nomination process;
 - Taking into account the set criteria and adopting a scientific-based assessment approach;
 - Simplifying the nomination files by optimizing their length and content;
 - Consolidating the processes pertaining to the preparation of the Tentative List;
 - Taking practical measures to support the Member States with files on the Tentative List pending assessment;
 - Ensuring that nomination files are drafted by competent parties in charge of preserving heritage in the Member States.
- 3- Calling upon the General Secretariat to devise suggestions that would ensure the implementation of the above procedures.

Decision No. 7: Inscription of New Heritage Sites and Cultural Elements on the Tentative List of Heritage in the Islamic World:

- ICESCO's General Directorate made a presentation in this regard;
- The Committee approved the inscription of seventy-two (72) heritage, historical, and natural sites, and cultural elements on the Tentative List² of Heritage in the Islamic World;
- The Committee called upon the General Secretariat to reach out to the Member States concerned with this decision to complete their files at the earliest convenience.

Decision No. 8: Inscription of Heritage Sites and Cultural Elements on the Final List of Heritage in the Islamic World:

After following the presentation of the ICESCO Directorate-General, the Committee approved two hundred and twelve 212³ properties and elements on the List of the Heritage of the Islamic World, distributed as follows:

- Thirty-four 34 cultural elements, i.e. fourteen (14) files evaluated and 20 elements from the Representative List of Humanity;
- One hundred and six (106) properties inscribed, i.e. 36 files evaluated and 70 files from the World Heritage List
- The Committee stressed the need to consider the observations of the Committee and the external experts, who assessed the submitted files;
- The Committee recommends contacting the Member States concerned to complete their nomination files taking into consideration the modifications suggested and additions requested by the assessors according to the annexed file;
- The Committee called upon the General Secretariat to reach out to Member States concerned with this decision to promote, restore, and enhance the inscribed sites and monuments at the national and international levels, with a view to developing activities generating income.

Decision No. 9: Proposal to Adopt the Amendment to the Rules of Procedure of the Islamic World Heritage Committee:

- ICESCO's General Directorate made a presentation in this regard;
- The Committee adopted the proposals of the General Secretariat and called for applying the new Rules of procedure;
- The Committee called upon the General Secretariat to reconsider the nomination files assessment process.

Decision No. 10: Forming a specialized work team to operate within the Open-ended Working Group on World Heritage

- Considering the proposal of the representative of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia on involvement in the international efforts to promote the status of Islamic world heritage on the world lists and giving it the value, it deserves on international lists;
- The Committee agreed to form a sub-committee composed of: Morocco, Benin, Kazakhstan, Oman, Senegal, Qatar, Azerbaijan
- Calling upon the General Directorate to network the representatives of these countries to hold periodic coordination meetings.

After analyzing the items on the agenda, observations and approval of ICESCO initiatives, the IWHC issued the following recommendations:

Recommendation No. 1: Calling upon the General Secretariat to dedicate a number of programs to raise the awareness of students and youth of the importance of cultural heritage in the Islamic world;

Recommendation No. 2: Calling upon the General Secretariat to hold intensive training workshops for workers in heritage sites and museums in the Member States;

Recommendation No. 3: Calling upon Member States to submit more files on heritage sites and intangible cultural heritage for inscription on the Islamic World Heritage List;

Recommendation No. 4: Entrusting the General Secretariat with preparing and updating a strategy to publicize heritage sites and cultural elements, inscribed on the Final List of Heritage in the Islamic World, through the use of alternative means and modern technologies to enrich the heritage portal of the Islamic world.

Recommendation No. 5: Forming a work team from among the Committee members, notably the representatives of Morocco, Benin, Kazakhstan, Oman, Senegal, Qatar and Azerbaijan to oversee the Program of Hajj Routes and Historical Mosques, and contribute effectively to its various implementation phases; Calling on the General Directorate to ensure networking among representatives of these countries for the holding of periodic coordination meetings;

Recommendation No. 6: Commending ICESCO's initiative on green transformation and its initiative on the development of a mechanism for monitoring and addressing the impacts of climate change as well as the natural and human disasters on heritage.



At the close of the meeting, the IWHC expressed its gratitude and appreciation to H.E. Dr. Salim M. AlMalik, ICESCO Director-General, for his keenness to hold this meeting. The Committee also thanked Dr. Mohamed Zinelabidine, Head of Culture and Communication Sector, for his availability, along with all experts from the Islamic World Heritage Center for the quality of the documents and the relevance of the projects submitted to them. The Committee encouraged ICESCO to continue this commendable effort to preserve, safeguard, and promote heritage, to initiate programs aimed at enhancing the cultural diversity of the Islamic world, and to maintain the regularity of the meetings of the Islamic World Heritage Committee.





Decisions (IWHC)







Introduction



The participants of the Twelfth Meeting of the Islamic World Heritage Committee (IWHC) organized in Shusha – cultural capital in the Islamic World for 2024;

Express their gratitude to the Republic of Azerbaijan for hosting this important Committee meeting in Shusha and the generous hospitality;

Noting that preservation of cultural heritage is of great importance for all peoples across the world. Any damage to cultural property, regardless of its origin, is a damage to the cultural heritage of all humanity, as reflected in the 1954 Hague Convention for the protection of cultural property in the Event of Armed Conflict. Therefore, strongly condemn targeting cultural and religious sites and monuments and their destruction during conflicts, especially in situation of occupation, regardless of their origin;

Reaffirming the critical importance of protection of cultural and religious heritage, revival of cultural environment and the commitment to the respective goals of the UN Agenda 2030 as essential for ensuring sustainable development, particularly in post-conflict situations;

Supporting significant reconstruction of the destroyed urban infrastructure being undertaken by the Government of Azerbaijan in the liberated territories;

Extending its unequivocal and firm support to humanitarian initiative of the Government of Azerbaijan in post-conflict period, aimed at restoring destructed historical monuments and infrastructures, reviving culture and heritage, establishing long-term sustainable peace, to revitalize cultural and religious heritage and promote successful models of post-conflict reconciliation that seeks to explore how philosophy of culture can contribute to strengthening peace;



Hereby decide to implement comprehensive and ambitious heritage agenda that offers renewed opportunities for the long-term protection and sustainable development of heritage within the Islamic World including its listing mechanisms and have taken the following decisions:

The Two-Year Vision and Strategies of the Heritage Center

Having considered the presentation made by ICESCO General Directorate, the Committee decides:

- Adopts the Document, taking account of the observations by the Committee Members;
- 2. Invites the Secretariat to disseminate the Document to the Member States to highlight the role of the Islamic World Heritage Center, and work toward implementing the presented vision at the wider scope in the Islamic world and beyond.
- 3. Stresses the need to protect heritage properties in conflict and war zones, including conducting a study to assess the magnitude of damage caused by the Israeli forces on heritage sites in Palestine, especially in Gaza, as well as Lebanon, with priority to damage caused in 2023-2024; calls on the Center to prepare a report on its action plan covering the mechanisms used to safeguard, restore and preserve heritage in the Islamic world; and invites the specialized international organizations and consultation bodies to contribute to the drafting of both the report and the action plan to safeguard these cultural properties.





Activity Report of the Center of Heritage in the Islamic World 2024

- Adopts the Document, taking account of the observations by the Committee Members;
- 2. Calls on the Secretariat to activate the Islamic World Heritage Portal and work toward pooling the Member States' efforts to obtain the necessary materials pertaining to the inscribed heritage sites, landmarks, and cultural elements to be displayed on the Portal.
- **3. Welcomes** the new partnerships developed by ICESCO and invites the Heritage Center to exert more efforts to network with international organizations with mutual interests.
- 4. Commends the publications of the Heritage Center: in 2024, and calls on the Secretariat to disseminate them to the Member States for the benefit of researchers and experts specializing in the fields of heritage protection in the Islamic world.
- 5. Invites the Secretariat to conduct studies and launch initiatives to develop national cultural policies to ensure the preservation and promotion of the Islamic world heritage, and work towards developing governance mechanisms and management methods, in cooperation with the Culture and Communication Sector, the Islamic World Heritage Center and the Islamic World Heritage Committee.





Proposed Inscription Methods and Processes for the Islamic World Heritage List

- 1. **Highlights** the need for a periodic review of the inscription process for the Islamic World Heritage List to ensure a balanced and credible list;
- 2. Stresses the need to simplify the inscription process to prompt the Member States having not yet submitted their nomination files to do so.
- **3.** Calls on to integrate the following measures in the review of the inscription process:
 - **Ensuring** autonomy and harmony during the nomination process;
 - Taking into account the set criteria and adopting a scientific-based assessment approach;
 - Developing more efficient and effective the nomination files;
 - Consolidating the processes pertaining to the Tentative List;
 - Devising practical measures to examine the Member States' files inscribed on the Tentative List and working towards removing cultural properties from the list of sites in danger;
 - Highlights the importance of preparing an evaluation model containing a description of the landmark, site or elements to be inscribed;
- **4. Adopts** the document and calls on the Secretariat to circulate it and implement this new reform approach.



Inscription of Tangible heritage on the Islamic World Heritage List

- Inscribes the heritage sites on the Tentative and Final Lists of Heritage in the Islamic World, as per the attached list.
- 2. Adopts the inscription of the Member States' sites inscribed on the List of World Heritage in Danger on the Final Islamic World Heritage List, and invites ICESCO to consult and coordinate with the Member States to design programs and hold workshops on these sites' removal for the benefit of heritage professionals in the Islamic world.
- 3. Invites the Secretariat to inform the Member States concerned of this decision to allow them to take the necessary measures to promptly inscribe their cultural properties on the Final List and finalize the nomination files of their sites inscribed on the Tentative List.
- 4. Invites the Member States to publicize their sites inscribed on the Islamic World Heritage List at the national, regional and international levels and take the necessary measures and adopt the best practices to ensure their effective management.
- 5. Calls on the Member States to finalize the files of their inscribed sites according to the observations made in order to be presented in ten months' time; and invites ICESCO to prepare a report thereon for submission to the next IWHC meeting.





Inscription of Cultural Elements on the Islamic World Heritage List:

- Inscribes the evaluated cultural elements on the Islamic World Heritage List, as per the attached list, taking into account the observations of the Committee members.
- 2. Takes into consideration the observations of the Committee and the external experts and adopt them in the evaluation of future nomination files.
- 3. Invites the Secretariat to contact the competent parties of the Member States concerned to urge them to incorporate the modifications and additions proposed by the evaluation experts to their respective nomination files, as per the attached document;
- 4. Invites the Secretariat to contact the Member States concerned to urge them to publicize the elements at the national and international levels.
- 5. Calls on the Member States to finalize the files of their inscribed sites according to the observations made in order to be presented in ten months' time; and invites ICESCO to prepare a report thereon for submission to the next IWHC meeting.





Activation of the Heritage Fund in the Islamic World

- Adopts the document, taking account of the observations by the Committee Members;
- 2. Invites the General Directorate to inform the Member States of the creation of the Fund and invite them to contribute thereto.
- 3. **Submit** the Fund to Their Excellencies the Ministers of Culture in the Islamic World for consideration at their next conference.
- 4. Invites ICESCO to devise measures to ensure the sustainability of the Fund's resources, in coordination with the Member States and international and national donors.
- 5. Invites the Secretariat to disseminate this Document to the Member States and highlights the need to find funding solutions to pioneering programs in the Islamic world and provide the necessary technical and financial support to ensure efficient management of heritage in the Islamic world and prevent the inscription of the Member States' cultural properties on the List of World Heritage in Danger.





Decision No. 8

Green Heritage

Having considered the presentation made by ICESCO's Heritage Center, the Committee decides the following:

- Adopts the document, taking account of the observations by the Committee Members;
- 2. Invites the Secretariat to disseminate this Document to the Member States, and highlights the need to invest in heritage sustainability in the Islamic world, and join international efforts to adopt new concepts relating to green heritage.
- Encourages the use of green heritage principles in the Islamic world's heritage sites and cultural elements.

Museums and Illicit trafficking of Cultural Properties in the Islamic World

- Adopts the Document, taking account of the observations by the Committee Members;
- 2. Invites the Secretariat to disseminate this Document and urges the Member States to support the Organization's work to join global efforts to devise a strategy to support museums and combat illicit trafficking of cultural properties.
- 3. Invites the General Directorate to hold more national, regional and international workshops to raise awareness of this phenomenon and involve different stakeholders including specialists and experts.



Cultural and Intellectual Register of the Islamic World

Having considered the presentation made by ICESCO's Heritage Center, the Committee decides the following:

- Adopts the Document, taking account of the observations of the Committee Members, and approves the creation of the Cultural and Intellectual Register.
- Invites ICESCO to create a registration measure for this Register comprising of standards and an evaluation process.
- Adopts the addition of Ibn Khaldun's Al-Muqaddimah to this Register.
- 4. Invites the Secretariat to disseminate this Document to the Member States and invite them to provide ICESCO with the key keys elements they desire to include in the Register to help preserve the collective memory of the Islamic world and promote the contributions of Muslim scholars and intellectuals throughout history.

13th Meeting of the Islamic World Heritage Committee (IWHC)

Having considered the offer submitted by the Republic of Uzbekistan to host the 13th Meeting of the Islamic World Heritage Committee, as part of the celebration of Samarkand as the 2025 Culture Capital in the Islamic World, the Committee decides the following:

- 1. Welcomes the kind offer of the republic of Uzbekistan to host the meeting.
- 2. Invites the Secretariat to coordinate with the competent authorities in Uzbekistan and the IWHC Chairman to set the date and prepare the agenda and documents of the Meeting.



The Committee issued the following recommendations:

Calling on the Secretariat to dedicate a number of programs to raise the awareness of officials, students and youth of the importance of cultural heritage in the Islamic world.

Calling upon the Secretariat to hold intensive training workshops for workers in heritage sites and museums in the Member States.

Calling upon Member States to submit more files on heritage sites and intangible cultural heritage for inscription on the Islamic World Heritage List.

Entrusting the Secretariat with preparing and updating a strategy to Definition heritage sites, monuments and elements, inscribed on the Final List of Heritage in the Islamic World using alternative means and modern technologies to enrich the Portal of Heritage in the Islamic World.
